PROSPECTOR AGREEMENT

- I will not use machinery, conduct significant excavation or disturb improvements without prior approval.
- I will comply with all applicable laws, regulations, permits and land-access requirements.
- I will immediately stop prospecting and leave the property if requested by the landowner.
